LORONIX HELPING SECURE G7

Denver, CO — On the heels of the September 11 attack on the United States and in preparation for the G7 Summit in 2002, Loronix will be expanding its installation in the airport in Calgary, Alberta, as the city enhances security to better serve its 8.7-million travelers.

The original system was to include about 400 cameras in a four-phase implementation process. That number has increased to approximately 600 cameras.

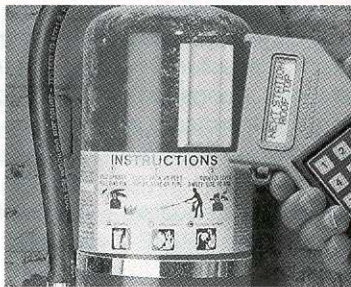
The Loronix system has already been implemented throughout the airport's four concourses, including immigration checkpoints and baggage areas. It has

been instrumental in both proactive security actions, which have yielded the arrest of drug smugglers and other criminals, and has been used for investigative purposes. Calgary Airport has also recognized the system's value in decreasing insurance payments that have been associated with the liability of passengers' property at security checkpoints after bags and other valuables are put through detectors.
